- No coverage of PLO diplomat Maen Rashid Areikat stating that "absolutely" no Jews could remain in a future Palestinian state. (Tablet 10/29/10)
- No coverage of the results of a poll by Greenberg Quinlan Rosner Research and the Palestinian Center for Public Opinion, sponsored by The Israel Project, showing 61% of Palestinians reject a two-state solution, 72% support denial of Jewish history in Jerusalem and 53% support teaching Palestinian schoolchildren to hate Jews.
- No coverage of Fatah Central Committee Member Abbas Zaki asserting, "If we say that we want to wipe Israel out...C'mon it's too difficult. It's not [acceptable] policy to say so. Don't say these things to the world. Keep it to yourself." (MEMRI translation from Al Jazeera 9/23/11)
