4. Agricultural Year: starts in October of every year and ends in September of the following year.

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


Estimated Population in Palestine by Governorate, 2016


Percentage Distribution of Palestinians in the World by Country of Residence, End 2016





Population Pyramid in Palestine, End 2016








Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and Above) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2016

Percentage Distribution of Monthly Household Consumption in Jordanian Dinars (JD) in Palestine by Commodities, Service Groups and Region, 2011




Individual Poverty Rates According to Household Consumption in Palestine by Region, 2011



Percentage Distribution of Persons (15 Years and Above) in Palestine by Educational Attainment, 2015








Percentage of Households Which have Computer by Governorate, 2014





Physicians, and Beds per 1000 Population in Palestine, 2005-2015













Percentage Distribution of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2015







Quantity of Annual Rainfall in the West Bank by Station Location, 2016 (mm)






